# Directions to Dundrod Presbyterian Church which is about twenty-five minutes from Belfast.

From the north or east via the M2. Come off the M2 and follow signs for International airport. At the roundabout about a mile before the airport, take the exit for Lisburn (A26). At the next roundabout, about 3 miles along, take the exit for Dundrod (B101). The church is at a crossroads about 2 miles along (on the right, with parking opposite).

From Belfast/ Bangor, go up the Crumlin Rd, on to the upper Crumlin Rd and left at traffic lights up the Ligoniel Rd (<u>before</u> the horseshoe bend). After a few miles, about 7, watch for the left turn for Lisburn. Take it, then about 2 miles along, you come to the crossroads mentioned above. The church will be facing you.

An alternative way from south Belfast is to go up Kennedy Way from the Balmoral Ave/Kennedy way junction of the M1. At roundabout, take second exit (still Kennedy Way). At next roundabout, take first exit (Glen Rd towards Glenavy, A 501). About a mile later, turn right up Hannahstown Hill and soon after left in to the upper Springfield Rd (B38). After 1.6 miles, right in to Wheelers Rd. half a mile later, right in to Tornagrough Rd. Follow that road (B154) to Dundrod.

From central Lisburn, there are clear signs to Dundrod.

From the west including Portadown/Lurgan etc, leave the M1 at the Moira exit and take the road to the International airport. At the Nutts Corner roundabout, do right round and take the exit for Dundrod. The church is at a crossroads about two miles from there.
